The Brazilian Amazon, Some Myths, Some Truths and a Few of Its Orchids

We are delighted to welcome Gilberto Castro, a native of Brazil, to speak to our society for the first time on Wednesday, April 5th. Gilberto will talk about the

hosting Gilberto during his visit to San Diego. Gilberto also will be speaking to SDCOS members on this same topic on Tuesday evening, April 4th in Balboa Park.

Gilberto Castro was born in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil on April 8, 1949. He lived in the US from 1965 to 1966, attending as a junior at Benson High School in Omaha, Nebraska. He returned to Brazil to continue his education and graduated in

PRESIDENTS' MESSAGE

Hello to all POS Members and Friends,

Spring is officially here, and we are enjoying the longer days with Daylight Savings Time. It's been an unusually wet winter and more rain is forecast in the month of March and early April. In California we have had 11 atmospheric river storms this season. Although many of the heavy storms and storm related damages have been in northern and central California, we have had a very wet winter in San Diego County that has recently opened sinkholes and resulted in some cliff collapse. The great news is we have reduced our usage of water and the drought may be over. Many of us have not had to water our outdoor orchids very much leaving more time for other activities.

Last month, we had two of our best POS orchid growers, Ken Campbell and Jerry Spencer, give us an excellent culture program. Jerry spoke about his "5 favorite Orchids, and Ken discussed "Orchid Pests and their Management". Thanks to both individuals for sharing their expertise with us. Thanks also to Jerry for providing the beautiful and generous opportunity table. Having expert POS members give talks is a nice deviation from talks by outside growers and it reduces society costs by not incurring speaker fees.

For our April program, we are sharing an international speaker with the San Diego Orchid Society. POS welcomes Mr. Gilberto Castro from Brazil who will talk on the "The Brazilian Amazon, Some Myths, Some Truths and a Few of Its Orchids". Information on Gilberto's interesting background and bio is included in the newsletter. We are pleased to work with our sister organization, SDCOS, on shared speakers and cooperating with them on several other activities.

An example of a currently shared activity is our joint support of the San Diego Botanic Garden's (SDBG) "World of Orchids" Show that recently opened from March 11-April 9. This is a beautiful exhibit that both societies have sponsored for the past three years. Most of the orchids are provided by members of our societies

and arranged by floral expert Rene van Rems and the garden staff. If you haven't seen the show yet, plan to do so as it is an outstanding exhibit. You have until April 9 to attend the show so please refer to the SD Botanic Garden's website for details (www.sdbg.org). POS will be conducting a fundraiser to sell orchids donated by members and vendors at this event between March 31st thru April 2nd in order to raise much needed funds for the society. Invite your friends to the show and pick up some nice orchid plants for your collection. POS members will volunteer to man our booth, sell orchids and distribute information about our society.

In March some of our members attended the Santa Barbara Orchid Show and visited local orchid nurseries in the area. We are pleased that the show was a success, especially after the show was not held the past three years due to Covid. It's important for our orchid hobbyists to participate in these shows, since they are an important activity for the financial success of the growers and vendors.

On June 10th, POS will hold another fundraiser to sell members orchids at the Dove Library (Gowland Room) in Carlsbad. Members are encouraged to donate plants for the sale, so please consider sharing some of your divisions or plants to help support POS. This is the second of two fundraisers of the year since, because of Covid, we have not had a sale for the past three years. As mentioned in prior newsletters, membership fees are not enough to cover the cost of operating the society. There are many expenses you are not aware of that have been increasing due to inflation and we typically have been running at a deficit for the last few years. Plan to attend the sale and invite your friends as we will have many beautiful plants for the sale. Please note, that this is the second orchid sale for us this year. In the past we have held an auction, but the POS Board decided to switch to a sales

Natural History at the "Instituto de Biologia", "Universidade Federal do Rio de Janeiro" in 1972, and at the "Faculdade de Educação" of the "Universidade Federal do Rio de Janeiro" in 1973.

As mentioned above, Gilberto has extensive experience in the Amazon, where he has traveled since 1975 and, over the last 47 years, has guided a number of different expeditions. He was a good friend of Margaret Mee, the famous British Botanical Illustrator, who discovered and documented in watercolors several new orchids in the Brazilian Amazon. He guided her

on the last of her 15 journeys to the Amazon in 1988. Moreover, he has guided 3 underwater filming trips for the Discovery Channel, 17 trips for the Margaret Mee Foundation, 5 trips for Kew Gardens of London, 39 Scientific Illustration trips with Illustrator Dulce Nascimento, participated on the film-

ing of the great "big screen" documentary Margaret Mee and the Moon Flower, and since 2015 has guided 5 trips for the OCA, in Rio Negro and some tributaries.

Gilberto was part of a 5 person team to go to the top of the Eldorado waterfall in 2014 and, in 2015, he was on the first team ever to reach the bottom of the Eldorado waterfall, the highest waterfall in the Brazilian Amazon. He also conducted countless eco-tours in the area and in the Pantanal (the wetlands on Midwest Brazil) that he crossed on off-road vehicles over 20 times on the 140 miles trek from east to west, and once on a solo crossing on foot on a west to east trek.

In addition to all this traveling, Gilberto started a business, sold it after 21 years, then did some computer programming for a small company in DOS based dBase program (some of it is still being used), and managed for some 20 years a sports fishing operation in the Amazon.

Gilberto's presentation is not to be missed especially if you want to experience the Amazon without the necessity of leaving the San Diego area. The April opportunity table will consist of orchids from Sunset Valley Orchids.

The Palomar Orchid Society regularly meets the **FIRST WEDNESDAY** of every month at the [George and Patricia Gowland Meeting Room located in the Carlsbad City Library](#) on Dove Lane, just off El Camino Real in southern Carlsbad. The address is [1775 Dove Lane, Carlsbad, CA 92011](#).

Traveling South on I-5, take the Poinsettia Ln. exit and travel east to El Camino Real. Turn right on El Camino Real and turn right again on Dove Lane.

If traveling North on I-5, take the La Costa Ave. exit and travel east to El Camino Real. Turn left on Dove Lane (first traffic light after Aviara Pkwy.)
