We are delighted to welcome back Peter Lin to our society. Peter is an excellent speaker who is quite knowledgeable on many classes of orchids, their growth and culture. Peter will speak on 'Favorite Fragrant Orchids'. Along with the beauty of the flowers, many orchids have an alluring fragrance that is hard to beat in the plant world. This fast paced PowerPoint presentation will highlight some of Peter's favorite orchids with truly fragrant flowers, and how to grow them.

Peter started growing orchids over 30 years ago, but then stopped due to school and

starting a career. It wasn't until about 14 years ago that the orchid "bug" came back and he is now heavily involved once again. He is an accredited judge with the American Orchid Society and a hybridizer of mini-catts. He enjoys meeting with other orchid enthusiasts, and can often be found at various orchid shows and societies around the country. small greenhouses, as well as an

offsite greenhouse.

General Meeting Information

The Palomar Orchid Society regularly meets the FIRST WEDNESDAY of every month at the Conference Center at Lake San Marcos (1105 La Bonita Dr., San Marcos, CA 92078). Traveling on State Route 78, take the Rancho Santa Fe exit and head South. The entrance to the Lake San Marcos Resort is on your left about a 1/4 mile South of the San Marcos Blvd. intersection. Traveling on I5 South from Oceanside and North Carlsbad, take the Palomar Airport exit and turn right onto Rancho Santa Fe after about 7 miles. Traveling North on I5 from South Carlsbad and Encinitas, for example, take the La Costa Ave. exit and turn left onto Rancho Santa Fe. The entrance to the resort will be the first right after the fire station in San Marcos. Inside the resort at the first "T" intersection, turn left on San Marino Drive. At the next 4-and way STOP, turn right on La Bonita Drive. Proceed ahead for one block on La Bonita. The conference center will be on the left and there is plenty of parking in front.

Thank you to those who signed up for our potting workshop on July 14th. Unfortunately, there were just too many competing opportunities for that weekend, so we didn't have enough people coming to proceed. We are going to try again in August! We hope that if you couldn't come in July, you will try to attend this make-up session. This is a great time for repotting your plants and, even more importantly, it's an excellent way to meet some of your officers and long-time members in a relaxed and friendly setting. We'll have lunch together with a dividing and potting demonstration followed by time to work on your own plants. There should be plenty of

friendly experienced members on hand to help you. We will meet at 12 pm for potluck lunch and then get to work. This event is planned for the afternoon because our work area will be in the shade then. Ben Machado will provide medium and a range of pots. We will also supply scissors, labels, stakes, gloves, etc., so you only need to bring your plants. For best results, they should be showing new root growth. That will insure that they take off and grow immediately with minimum transplant shock. We are asking for a nominal fee of \$3 per plant to cover the supplies you use. Ben will also have a few other items on hand for sale if you need them. Please bring a lunch dish to share. We'll provide drinks and utensils. You are invited to enjoy the meal and conversation and take a tour of Debby's greenhouse and gardens before or after the workshop. Please sign up in
