PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Hello to all POS Members and Friends,

It's only February but we are already planning our calendar of events for the new year. Our challenge is to bring our members and friends another solid year of great programs and speakers, orchid events and fundraising activities. To fulfill our goals, we need more members to 'actively' participate, not just attend meetings and buy Opportunity Table tickets!! We announce in each newsletter that we need more volunteers but get minimal response. Last month's speaker, Carol Beule, indicated over dinner that her home orchid society did not meet during much of Covid. We are aware of other societies that also took a long break from in-person meetings. POS took a short break and shared Zoom meetings with the San Diego County Orchid Society, but we resumed as soon as we felt safe. We made the right decision because our attendance has increased versus pre-covid. Our members and friends strongly prefer in person meetings and speakers. But planning programs takes a lot of effort. Alex and Bill will be approaching members to gather more support, so we ask that you step up and be more active.

In January Carol Beule, a first-time speaker to POS, gave an excellent overview of Sarcochilus orchids. In February we welcome Donna Ballard, another new speaker. Donna's presentation will be "Growing Orchids in the Middle of a Drought". Although we are technically not in drought conditions at this time, we know that the water situation can quickly change from year to year, and we need to be prepared to be water wise with orchids. Donna is coming to POS as part of our shared speaker program with SDCOS. More on Donna's back-

ground is included on the first page of this newsletter.

While we have two new speakers to start the year, we will not abandon our regular slate of excellent local speakers. These include Fred Clark of SVO, Tim Culbertson, Peter Lin and others.

One of the first major events POS will participate in is the San Diego Botanical Garden's "World of Orchids" showcase (May 4-27th) in the Dickinson Family Education Conservatory. Many of our members have participated in this event the past two years by loaning plants for the display over the 4-week exhibit period. One of our main fundraisers is held on one of the weekends. SDBG will allocate one or two weekends for POS to sell orchids and to share our knowledge of orchids with visitors. We ask our members to start setting aside divisions they can donate to the fundraiser. Most of the plants we sell are from member donations with a few blooming plants purchased from local and Hawaiian orchid growers. Members also volunteer in the POS Sales Booth on our weekend or weekends.

We also will plan our POS orchid caravan before or after the May show.

The past two months have been very cold and created challenges for those of us with outdoor growing structures. It's difficult to control the weather and most of us have large collections that cannot come indoors. One of the steps some of us take is to place a cover

(shade cloth or tarp) directly over the plants in the evening. This may help protect the plant for those coldest nights. Also keep your orchids on the dry side and only water during warmer periods. Refer to the AOS and the POS websites for the Monthly Checklist for January and February.

In January and February, we encourage all our members to renew their membership. The fees have increased to \$30 for individuals and \$35 for family memberships. As initiated in 2023, late registrations will incur a \$5 increase if not paid in a timely manner. Members may pay in person at meetings our online on our website at www.palomarorchid.org
