PRESIDENTS' MESSAGE

Happy New Year to all POS Members and Friends,

We wish all of you a joyous holiday and a wonderful new year. It's the season to spend time with family and friends. For those of you who are traveling, we wish you a safe and speedy journey.

It sounds like a prerecorded message, but POS had another fantastic year. We had numerous excellent speakers, many returning members and several new members who have embraced our society. These new members are enjoying our programs and our friendly members. Several new members joined near the end of the year and others are joining in early 2024. One comment we sometimes receive from new (and older) members is they like POS because we are a small society that is welcoming to visitors and new members, and we are especially helpful to beginners. We also had a year without any major illnesses for our members. We are thankful for all of this.

POS held its annual holiday dinner on December 6th, and everyone had a great time, delicious Chinese food from Chin's Gourmet La Costa, nice desserts and a blooming orchid from 808 Orchids of Hawaii. One of the desserts was provided by Anita and Jerry Spencer who celebrated their 54th Wedding Anniversary on that night. Additional desserts were provided by several other members. We had nearly 40 attendees and it was a fun and festive occasion. Several people commented that it was one of our nicest holiday dinners ever and they enjoyed the food from Chins.

For the November meeting we did not have a live speaker. Instead, we had an AOS webinar presentation by George Hatfield of Hatfield Orchids. It was an excellent presentation on how he grows award winning cymbidiums and contained information that would be beneficial to all of us, especially during the upcoming cymbidium season. We had a slightly smaller turnout than normal probably because many of our members prefer live speakers, but those who did not attend missed an outstanding presentation. One of our visitors commented that she learned a lot from the program. We will consider other webinars when we are unable to schedule a speaker or unable to plan a Culture Class.

In December, we received a generous donation of more than 40 orchids from Nate La Breche, a POS member. Nate was planning on moving out of state and would not be able to take his orchid collection with him. All of the orchids are in excellent condition, and several are unusual plants that we don't see at local shows. POS thanks Nate for his generous donation. Many of these plants will be available on the January opportunity table and the silent auction table.

As mentioned in previous newsletters and at meetings, it takes a lot to run the POS Society. Membership dues cover less than 1/3 of our operating costs which includes meeting room fees, speaker expense, opportunity table costs, administrative fees and other expenses. Our successful fundraisers this year which included the San Diego Botanic Garden Sale and the Dove Library Sale were critical to raising funds but still not sufficient to cover all costs. Thanks to all our members for volunteering plants and their time.

At the end of the year, we also received a monetary donation from Shelley and Bill Wong which was enough to pay for the Dove Library room expense for a full year. This donation helped us be in the black for 2023 and we did not have to dip into our reserve to cover shortfalls. We want to remind our members that POS is a 501 (3)(c) Charitable Organization and donations are allowable tax deductions as provided by the federal tax code. So please consider POS for your 2024 charitable donations. Also at the end of 2023, Alex, Bill and Jim helped remove all of the POS items from our storage unit. We are storing some boxes at home and other items were donated or tossed. We determined that the cost of storage (about \$1200 annually) could be eliminated with minimal impact.

For January 2024, we welcome Carol Beule who will speak to POS on 'Sarcochilus, a Native of Australia'. This is Carol's first visit to POS and she is coming to San Diego as part of our shared speaker program with SDCOS. She will be speaking to SDCOS on January 2nd on 'Lycastes.' More on Carol's background is included in the speaker section above. POS will continue this shared speaker arrangement with our sister society for 2024 as it benefits both societies and enables us to have speakers who would not normally come to San Diego.

At our November meeting, we committed to having an Orchid Caravan in 2024. Because of Covid and other reasons, we have not had a Caravan for several years. For 2024 we promise to have a caravan to a member's home!! If we do not come through, Bill has agreed to resign from his position as Co-President!!!

During the winter we get a little break from ur orchid activities. The cooler weather with intermittent rain means we do not have to water our orchids as frequently. It's also the time when we our cymbidiums and cattleyas are starting to spike or are in sheath, so we can



enjoy our plants rather than spending a lot of time repotting.

For more specific tips on what to do during January-April, look at the POS and AOS websites for other culture tips.

In January, we encourage all our members to renew their membership. The fees have increased to \$30 for individuals and \$35 for family memberships. As initiated in 2023, late registrations will incur a \$5 increase if not paid in a timely manner.

unique climate she has in the San Fernando Valley and the surrounding communities. In the search to find the perfect plant for her growing area, Carol now grows *Neofinetia* (*Vanda*) *falcata*, Paphiopedilum, Phalaenopsis, Cattleya, Laelia, Dendrobium, Lycaste, Asian Cymbidiums and Rossioglossum orchids on her patio and in two small greenhouses.

Carol is a Fully Accredited American Orchid Society Judge, the 1st VP of the Orchid Society of Southern California, and is on the committee that creates the Society's display for the Huntington's annual October Orchid Show. Carol has grown orchids for 28 years and grows orchids in two small greenhouses and outside in her yard in Studio City, CA.

When Carol retired, she started making ceramic pots for Japanese/Korean/Chinese orchids including *Neofinetia* (*Vanda*) *falcata*, Asian Cymbidiums and other small orchids. You can view Carol's exquisite pots on her <u>website</u>.

Carol recently wrote an article for the American Orchid Society monthly magazine on the pots used to display *Vanda falcata* in Japan and the US.

The article was illustrated using some photos taken by her and other OSSC members. The 1st part was started in February of 2022, and continued in the July and August 2022 issues of *Orchids*. The articles include many beautiful pictures of *Neofinetia falcatas* and related orchids.
