Form and Color of Asian Cymbidiums

Our society is delighted to welcome Jack Zhu for the first time as our speaker on Wednesday, June 7th at 6:30 pm. Jack is a shared speaker with SDCOS and will speak with our sister society on Tuesday evening June 6th in Balboa Park. Jack will speak with us on the 'Form and Col-

or of Asian Cymbidiums'. He will give a brief introduction of Asian cymbidium history as well as the main species typically accepted in the Asian cymbidium culture. Then, Jack will go into details about the various flower forms and colors of various Asian cymbidiums. In the end, Jack will briefly go over another talk he is working on, the leaf variegation of Asian cymbidiums and conduct a potting demo on Asian cymbidiums. It is a talk not to be missed. Jack also will supply this month's plant table.

Hello to all POS Members and Friends,

We hope everyone is well and enjoying the beautiful and fragrant flowers that our orchids are producing. We don't know about everyone else, but this year was one of the best in recent memory. Maybe all that rain we had this winter benefited our orchid collections. It seems like more of our cymbidiums, zygos and cattleyas have bloomed.

We want to remind everyone that June is a very important month in our fundraising efforts. POS has planned an orchid sale on Saturday, June 10th in the Gowland Room at the Carlsbad Dove Library (the same room we meet in). It will be held from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. There will be orchids from local growers (including Cal Orchids in Santa Barbara), from Hawaiian growers and donations from our members. Attendees will be able to purchase blooming and non-blooming orchids at good prices for their collections. Please plan to participate in this sale and invite your friends and relatives. This is our second and final fundraiser of 2023 and is critical to help cover our operating expenses.

Please support POS by donating divisions from your collections. Contact Alex or Bill to arrange to drop off or pick up plants. You can also bring your donations to the June meeting. We ask that you donate plants that are cleaned up and in good



condition with pictures for non-blooming plants, if possible. We will not have time clean up or repot plants.

For June, we welcome a first-time speaker, Jack Zhu from Los Angeles. Jack will speak to both SDCOS and POS as part of our shared speaker program. This shared arrangement has benefited both societies and enables us to host speakers who might not travel to San Diego otherwise. Jack is being hosted by Debbie Halliday (President of SDCOS). Jack is an expert on Asian Cymbidiums and his topic will be 'The Form and Color of Asian Cymbidiums'. He also plans on a cymbidium repotting demonstration so, if you need help on this task, be sure to come to the meeting

or join us via zoom. More details on Jack's bio are in this newsletter.

As much as we enjoy our regular speakers, one of our objectives is to introduce new speakers to our membership. Jack will be the second new speaker this year. We also are in discussions with SDCOS on hosting a speaker from Hawaii, which is a bit more expensive because of travel costs, but strong fundraisers will give us the finances to consider these options.

Along with cost increases for many of our household items, we have seen increased costs for orchids and orchid supplies. Orchid bark and plastic pots are not sold in many of our local big box stores and are in limited supply and selection at our local garden centers. We typically do not recommend specific stores, but some of the best prices and selections can be found at Yamada Company in Gardena, California. They have an extensive selection of orchid supplies at good prices, including orchid bark, plastic pots, GROW MORE fertilizer, bamboo stakes and plant labels. We know of at least two orchid growers who have purchased orchid bark from Yamada. If you and a friend are willing to share a ride to Gardena, you can stock up on supplies and cover your fuel costs.

We hope our members and friends remain healthy, upbeat and optimistic about the future. We are always thinking about our members who are unable to attend due to serious health issues and hope that all of you continue in good health.



General Meeting Information

The Palomar Orchid Society regularly meets the FIRST WEDNESDAY of every month at the George and Patricia Gowland Meeting Room located in the Carlsbad City Library on Dove Lane, just off El Camino Real in southern Carlsbad. The address is 1775 Dove Lane, Carlsbad, CA 92011.

Traveling South on I-5, take the Poinsettia Ln. exit and travel east to El Camino Real. Turn right on El Camino Real and turn right again on Dove Lane.

If traveling North on I-5, take the La Costa Ave. exit and travel east to El Camino Real. Turn left on Dove Lane (first traffic light after Aviara Pkwy.) Traveling West on S-78, take the San Marcos Blvd. exit and travel west, continuing on Palomar Airport Rd.. Turn left on El Camino Real and then turn right on Dove Lane.

The Dove library will be on your left and there is a large, well-lit parking lot. The Gowland Meeting Room is located on the right hand side of the main entrance.
