### San Diego County Fair Update with Volunteers Needed for the June 7 Orchid Repotting Demo

For those of you who are interested in entering your orchids in the 2017 San Diego County Fair orchid competition, the county fair website is still open for online registration for individuals who wish to participate. You have until May 12 to complete your registration to compete for ribbons and cash awards associated with the ribbons. Go to SDFAIR.com and select "participate" then select "competitive exhibits" then scroll down until you see the flowers box and select "flower show." When you select flower show "enter now", you will be taken to a screen that starts your registration process. Hit the "register button." You will need to use a credit card to pay the registration fee. Follow the prompts to get to the screen where you select whether you want to register for one show, or all 5 shows. There is one show per week during the duration of the fair (entries due the mornings of June 1, 6, 13, 19, and 26 from 6:30 am -10:30 am). It is a good idea to print out and read the rules before registering. Orchids are <u>the last two</u> Divisions, 5100 and 5101.

### General Meeting Information

The Palomar Orchid Society regularly meets the **FIRST WEDNESDAY** of every month at the <u>Pavilion at Lake San Marcos</u> (1105 La Bonita Dr., San Marcos, CA 92078).

Traveling on State Route 78, take the Rancho Santa Fe exit and head South. The entrance to

the Lake San Marcos Resort is on your left about a 1/4 mile South of the San Marcos Blvd. intersection. Traveling on I5 South from Oceanside and North Carlsbad, take the Palomar Airport exit and turn right onto Rancho Santa Fe after about 7 miles. Traveling North on I5 from South Carlsbad and Encinitas, for example, take the La Costa Ave. exit and turn left onto Rancho Santa Fe. The entrance to the resort will be the first right after the fire station in San Marcos.

Inside the resort at the first "T" intersection, turn left on San Marino Drive. At the next 4-way STOP, turn right on La Bonita Drive. Proceed ahead for one block on La Bonita. The pavilion will be on the left and there is parking in front of the pavilion.

- Exit 51 on I-15 (Mission Rd., Fallbrook)
- Turn East and go to the end (75 Yards)
- Turn left onto Old Hwy. 395 and continue going North to Fifth St.
- Turn right, go past the school to the only stop sign
- Turn left onto Rainbow Valley Blvd.

- At Causey Way, turn right onto dirt road (cactus farm on the right)
- Follow Causey Way to the Spencer's house on the right

Alternatively, <u>here are the Google Map</u> <u>directions</u> from the freeway to the unmapped Causey Way intersection. Use "2579 Rainbow Valley Blvd., Fallbrook" on your own GPS/mapping app to get you there, turn right onto Causey Way and follow that dirt road to the Spencer's house on the right.

With only a handful of plants left to repot (they are currently in bloom, so I want to wait a bit), I am feeling like I have finally caught up on the last two or three years of procrastination. While I am far from proud of the latter, I am quite happy with where things are now... if it wasn't for those pesky rodents I have in the yard. Not having paid close enough attention, several plants of mine had been radically grazed on and a few others had their roots nibbled on by those furry pests.

After trying poison bait stations for a few weeks, the results were rather mixed: the bait was eaten, but the rodents stayed alive (as evident from their droppings). According to Fred Clarke, whom I sought advice from, this is likely due to the "wimpy" concentration of poison in the consumer-level products available. So back to the old snap-traps it was, with Fred's trick of jamming a bit of tortilla under the trigger paddle. Lo and behold, as of a few days ago, there is now one fewer of these, what turned out to be roof rats, harassing my collection!
