months of September and October. The AOS site provides tips on specific orchids such as Cattleyas, Cymbidium, Dendrobi-


ums, etc. The checklist is well-written and easy to understand.

Traveling South on I-5, take the Poinsettia Ln. exit and travel east to El Camino Real. Turn right on El Camino Real and turn right again on Dove Lane.




